## Fundraising Survey Results

54% happy with amt. of Fundraising Events we currently run, 30% want to see more!

44% love a Fete or Musical during the year, 34% support a voluntary P&C levy

Comments on what they **loved** about past Fetes revolved around the fun of the day for the kids, community building, atmosphere, stalls and interactive kid's activities.

Things respondents **didn't enjoy** included: volume of work req, amount of non-green waste, pressure on parents to donate or be on long shifts, too much sugar, expensive wrist bands, profit as primary goal.

70% say they currently participate in Fundraising Events, work and time commitments are the major reason for non-participation.
