Recent study tours have included visits to The Australian Institute of Sport, The National Gallery, The Indonesian Embassy, Questacon, The National Exhibition Centre, The National Museum and many other fantastic venues around Canberra. Students are accompanied by their classroom teachers and other school staff members.
