Parking at School Safely

Do's

- Say goodbye on the school side of the road.
- Walk across the road to meet your children after school, always use the pedestrian or school crossings
- Try to leave home early to avoid arriving at the busiest times
- Follow the directions of all signs
- Park a safe distance from all crossings
- Always single park (double parking causes accidents and traffic jams)
- Organise a safe place to meet your children in case you are late for collection
- Report illegally parked vehicles
- Be aware, responsible, courteous and SAFE

Don't

- Don't Park in a loading zone
- Don't stop on crossings or on the road 20 meters before or 10m meters after the crossing. Keep a safe distance
- Don't stop or park in a No Standing Zone or bus zone.
- Don't park on a yellow line or over a driveway
- Don't park facing the wrong way, or on a footpath or nature strip
