## Winter Uniforms orders close Friday 27 March

Please order by Friday 27 March, you will need to pre-order and pay for these, as the Uniform Shop does not carry stock of our winter uniforms.

Students require either the track top or jacket, you aren't required to purchase both. Plain black track pants or tights/leggings are also acceptable.

You can select either delivery to your child's classroom or collection from the Uniform Shop.

Orders will be received from suppliers in Term 2, as they are made to order. Expected delivery date is Thursday 23 April. Alternatively, in Term 2 we will have a supply of second-hand winter uniforms available from the Uniform Shop for \$5.00 each.

## Meeting Guide

**Motions** occur frequently during meetings and usually involve an expenditure of funds or a decision to be made. The process is: someone moves an action, someone else seconds the motion, and discussion is held.

Once completed, a vote is held. If the majority agree, the motion passes and the actions associated with the motion are recorded. If it is not passed, the motion is not carried. Voting usually takes place with a show of hands. We encourage people to question the motion and not to vote for it if they aren't comfortable in supporting that decision.
